IT IS ORDERED that Defendants' Motion to Dismiss is granted in part and denied in part.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on or before October 23, 2009, plaintiff shall make a more definite statement of her First Amendment Retaliation claim in Count I pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(e), or plaintiff's First Amendment Retaliation claim may be dismissed for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff's Equal Protection claims in Count I are dismissed against all defendants.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Count I is dismissed against defendant Delaware County Community College.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Counts IV, V, VI, and VII of plaintiff's Complaint are dismissed in their entirety.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Defendants' Motion to Dismiss is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendants shall have until November 12, 2009 to answer plaintiff's Complaint.
