Plaintiff's Reply to Defendants' "Statement of Undisputed Facts" Contra Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment and Exhibits P1-P6 were filed simultaneously with his brief in opposition.

Complaint, and Count II is **DISMISSED** in its entirety.<sup>3</sup>
