



AND NOW, this 28<sup>th</sup> day of January 2019, upon consideration of Plaintiffs’ Motion for Remand and Attorney Fees (ECF Nos. 11 & 14), Defendants’ Response in Opposition to Plaintiffs’ Motion for Remand (ECF No. 20), Community Health Systems, Inc.’s Brief in Opposition to Plaintiffs’ Motion for Remand (ECF No. 21), Plaintiffs’ Reply (ECF No. 22), and in accordance with the Court’s accompanying Memorandum, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **DECREED** that Plaintiffs’ Motion for Remand and Attorney Fees (ECF Nos. 11 & 14) is **GRANTED in PART and DENIED in PART**.
