



b. When adjudicating the matter on remand, USCIS shall not rely on its factual finding that Plaintiffs' ability to communicate in English during the 2016 interview was attributable to the passage of years between the first and second interviews. Rather, per its mandate, USCIS shall consider all other probative evidence on the subject of Plaintiffs' ability to communicate with one another.
