ORDER

Plaintiff filed a request for subpoenas on August 26, 2008. Plaintiff has had two cases in this court, the first being the instant case, docketed at 3:07cv1677 and the second docketed at 3:07cv1113. The instant case is closed, and plaintiff's appeal of our order dismissing the case has been denied. (Doc. 21).
