ORDER

NOW, this 12th day of DECEMBER, 2011, upon consideration of the Report and Recommendation (“R&R”) filed by Magistrate Judge Martin C. Carlson, (Doc. 431), stating that Plaintiff has reached a settlement of all claims as to Defendants Cooper, Miller, and Moore and recommending that a 60-day order be issued, and in the absence of objections, **IT IS HEREBY**

ORDERED THAT:

1. The R&R (Doc. 431) is **ADOPTED**;

4. The matter is **REMANDED** to Magistrate Judge Carlson for further proceedings.
