To Whom It May Concern:

I have prepared this document pursuant to request by my above patient. In April of 2009, Attorney Reisinger was attacked and suffers a serious brain concussion. In addition to many other injuries after a three month recovery process, I as his treating physician, released him to return to his law practice on a part-time, approximately 70% basis. Additionally, in order to maintain his current health status I have encouraged him to take frequent breaks during each work day.

At this point, he has returned to his law practice on a part time basis. There has been no evidence of continuing difficulties that he has experienced due to the above mentioned injuries.

Because of his current physical and mental condition, it would be important for him to limit himself to four hours per day on a concentrated basis. His participation and depositions or other similar proceedings so as to allow him to maintain his current health status is restricted to the above four hour interval.
