AND NOW, THIS _____ DAY OF JUNE, 2017, in accordance with the

accompanying Memorandum Opinion, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- Plaintiff's Motion to Preclude Inadmissible Lay Opinion Testimony (Doc. 181) is ruled on as follows:
 - a. Whether Sanghera and Strauss will be precluded from offering opinion testimony as to fault for the accident at issue is **RESERVED UNTIL TIME OF TRIAL**.
 - b. Whether Strauss will be precluded from offering opinion testimony as to the speed of Plaintiff's vehicle is **RESERVED UNTIL TIME OF TRIAL**.
 - c. To the extent that Plaintiff's motion requests that Strauss be precluded from testifying as to why he believes the accident occurred, the motion is DENIED.

- d. Plaintiff's request that Strauss be precluded from testifying as to how long
 Green's tractor-trailer was on the roadway prior to impact is **DENIED**.
