AND NOW, THIS \_\_\_\_\_DAY OF DECEMBER, 2016, upon *de novo* review of Magistrate Judge Carlson's Report & Recommendation, (Doc. 46), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- The Report & Recommendation, (Doc. 46), is ADOPTED for the reasons discussed therein.
- 2. Defendant Tina Tedesco's Objection,¹ (Doc. 51), is OVERRULED. Tina Tedesco's objection, liberally construed, is that third degree murder is not a killing under the Slayer Act. In Pennsylvania, however, a "record of a murder conviction conclusively establishes a wilful and unlawful killing under the Slayer's Act." In re Klein's Estate, 378 A.2d 1182, 1186 n.21 (Pa. 1977).
- 3. Defendants John and Tina Tedesco's Motions to set aside the default judgements, (Docs. 36 & 38), are **DENIED**.
