Judge Schwab's Report and Recommendation ("R&R") (Doc. 55) for clear error or manifest injustice, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The R&R (Doc. 55) is **ADOPTED** for the reasons set forth therein.
- 2. Defendant Lackawanna Acquisition I, LLC d/b/a Lackawanna Health and Rehabilitation Center's Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 9) is **GRANTED**.
- The Motion to Dismiss by Defendants County of Lackawanna, the Area Agency on Aging, and Lackawanna County Commissioners Patrick O'Malley, Laureen Cummings, and Jerry Notarianni (Doc. 10) is GRANTED.
- 4. Advocacy Alliance, Inc.'s Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 14) is GRANTED.
- 5. Serving Seniors, Inc.'s Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 17) is **GRANTED**.

- 6. Plaintiff's Complaint (Doc. 1) is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.** Plaintiff shall file an Amended Complaint within **21 days of the date of this Order**. Failure to file an Amended Complaint may result in the dismissal of this action.
- 7. The case is **REMANDED** to Magistrate Judge Schwab for further proceedings consistent with this Order.
