A. Richard Caputo United States District Judge

The Report and Recommendation discusses Plaintiff's failure to properly serve Defendants and recommends Plaintiff be given the opportunity to do so. Since the issuance of the Report and Recommendation, however, Plaintiff appears to have properly served Defendants, (see Docs. 24-26), and Defendants have filed a renewed motion to dismiss. (See Doc. 28).
