- 1. The R&R (Doc. 46) is ADOPTED in part.
- Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 36) is **DENIED IN PART** and **GRANTED IN** PART.
- 3. The Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 36) is **DENIED** as to the following claims:
  - a. Retaliation under the ADA
  - b. Hostile Work Environment under the ADA
  - c. Failure to Accommodate under the ADA

- d. Disability Discrimination under the ADA
- e. Retaliation under the FMLA
- f. Fraud
- g. Intentional Infliction of Emotional Distress
- h. Fourteenth Amendment Due Process against Lackawanna County in connection with Plaintiff's October 19, 2016, and November 1, 2016, Pre-Termination Notices
- 4. The Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 36) is **GRANTED** in all other respects.
- 5. This case goes forward only as to the claims identified in  $\P$  3.
- 6. This matter is **REMANDED** to Magistrate Judge Mehalchick for further proceedings.
