ORDER


AND NOW, THIS *23rd* **DAY OF OCTOBER 2020,** upon consideration of

Plaintiff's Application for Attorney Fees Under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28-USCS § 2412 (Doc. 32) and all relevant documents, for the reasons discussed in the simultaneously filed Memorandum Opinion, **IT IS HEREY ORDERED THAT:**

1. Plaintiff's Application for Attorney Fees Under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28-USCS § 2412" (Doc. 32) is **GRANTED AS MODIFIED;**
2. Plaintiff is awarded a total of \$8511.06 in attorney fees and \$153.00 in administrative fees for a **total award of \$8,664.06.**
