

AND NOW, THIS 6th DAY OF MARCH, 2018, upon *de novo* review of Magistrate Judge Saporito's Report and Recommendation ("R&R") (Doc. 4), Gloria Sun Jung Yun's Objections thereto¹ (Doc. 5), and all other relevant documents, **IT IS HEREBY**

ORDERED THAT:

1. Gloria Sun Jung Yun's Objections (Doc. 5) are **OVERRULED**.
2. The R&R (Doc. 4) is **ADOPTED** for the reasons set forth therein.
3. The above-captioned matter is **REMANDED** to the Magisterial District Court of Monroe County (MDJ-43-2-01).
4. The Clerk of Court is directed to **CLOSE** the case.

¹ The Court notes that Gloria Sun Jung Yun does not appear to object to any of the Magistrate Judge's substantive findings or his ultimate recommendation. Instead, she takes issue with the R&R's characterization of her in a footnote (Doc. 4, at 2 n.2) as a "sovereign citizen" or "redemptionist." (See Doc. 5, at 3 ("Yun agree[s] that case should be closed for lack of jurisdiction but she is been [sic] injured by these judges' opinion with [sic] lacks evidences but allegation that Yun 'appears' to be 'Sovereign Citizen' and 'redemptionist' . . .").
