- 1) Defendants' motion to dismiss (Doc. 17) is **GRANTED**;
- Plaintiff's disparate treatment claim asserted in Count Two of the amended complaint pursuant to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 is **DISMISSED** with prejudice;
