MEMORANDUM ORDER

This civil rights action was received by the Clerk of Court on September 1, 2006, and was referred to United States Magistrate Judge Susan Paradise Baxter for report and recommendation in accordance with the Magistrates Act, 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1), and Rules 72.1.3 and 72.1.4 of the Local Rules for Magistrates.

The Magistrate Judge's Amended Report and Recommendation [Doc. No. 22], filed on August 20, 2007, recommended that Defendants' motion to dismiss or in the alternative for summary judgment [Doc. No. 14] be granted. The parties were allowed ten (10) days from the date of service to file objections. Service was made on Plaintiff by certified mail and on Defendants. Plaintiff was granted an extension until September 17, 2007 to file objections [Doc. No. 23]. No objections were filed. After de novo review of the motion and documents in the case, together with the Report and Recommendation, the following order is entered:
