MEMORANDUM ORDER

Having carefully reviewed the transcript of the Motions Hearing on June 17, 2015 (see Doc. 118), the Court concludes that Magistrate Judge Baxter’s ruling regarding the subpoenas directed to Plaintiffs’ former counsel was neither clearly erroneous nor contrary to law.
