- 6) The parties shall file any motions  $\underline{\text{in}}$   $\underline{\text{limine}}$ , proposed points for charge and proposed voir dire no later than July 20, 2009.
- 7) The nonmoving party's response to any motion  $\underline{in}$   $\underline{limine}$  shall be due no later than  $\underline{August 3, 2009}$ .
- 8) The court will conduct a pretrial conference on Friday, August 28, 2009, at 2 p.m..
- 9) The case shall presumptively be called for jury selection and trial on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>September 8, 2009 at 9:30 a.m.</u>.

10) All other aspects of the Court's Final Scheduling Order, dated June 18, 2008, shall remain in full force and effect.
