AND NOW, comes ALONZO LAMAR JOHNSON, Defendant in the above-captioned matter, by and through his counsel, Brian D. Aston, Esquire, and Belden Law, and files the following Motion for Extension of Time in Which to File Pre-Trial Motions and in support thereof avers the following:

1. The Pre-Trial Motions in the instant matter are due September 24, 2009.

6. The Office of the United States Attorney does not object to a sixty (60) day extension of time in which to file Pre-Trial Motions in the instant matter.
