MEMORANDUM ORDER

William Brandon Cummings's civil rights complaint was received by this Court on January 30, 2009, and was referred to United States Magistrate Judge Cathy Bissoon for pretrial proceedings in accordance with the Magistrates Act, 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1), and Rules Rules 72.C and 72.D of the Local Rules for Magistrates.

The Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation, filed on October 8, 2009, recommended that the Defendants' Partial Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 18) be granted in part and denied in part. The parties were allowed ten days from the date of service to file objections. Service was made on Plaintiff by First Class United States Mail at his place of incarceration. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Partial Motion to Dismiss filed by Defendants (Doc. 18) is GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART.
