12 A Temporary Restraining Order is entered, expiring on
13 **September 15, 2008, at 5:00 P.M.**, as requested in the Verified
14 Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief filed today.

15 Until expiration of the Temporary Restraining Order or further
16 Order of this court, the Defendants will comply with the contractual
17 provisions requiring them to continue supplying durable medical
18 equipment to any of Plaintiffs' insured until the services are
19 transitioned to a new supplier. Defendants, their agents,
20 employees, and all persons acting on their behalf, are forbidden
21 from discontinuing providing the mentioned durable medical equipment
22 to Plaintiffs' insured, who are Medicare beneficiaries, while the
23 temporary restraining order is in effect.

24 A Hearing where Defendants will show cause as to why a
25 preliminary injunction should not be entered will be held on
26 **September 10, 2008, at 9:30 A.M.** Plaintiffs are expected to serve

1 summons, the complaint, and a copy of this Order upon Defendants
2 **immediately, and not later than Tuesday, September 9, 2008, at**
3 **3:00 P.M.**

4 Plaintiffs are granted until **Wednesday, September 10, 2008,** to
5 post a bond in the amount of \$20,000.00.
