

3 the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York. Additionally, Ms. Finianos
4 was treated for injuries resulting from the alleged incident by medical professionals from the Jamaica
5 Hospital. Furthermore, co-defendant ASMO, which is in the business of providing passenger
6 assistance services for airlines, has no connection whatsoever to Puerto Rico, as it conducts no
7 business in Puerto Rico. Finally, all of the potential witnesses identified by ASMO as part of its
8 defense are residents of New York.

9 Therefore for the convenience of the parties, and in the interests of justice, defendants'
10 motion to transfer under 28 U.S.C. 1404(a) is **GRANTED**. The instant case will be transferred to
11 the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York.
