## ORDER

On August 20, 2015, United States Magistrate Judge Lincoln D. Almond issued a Report and Recommendation ("R&R") in the above-captioned matter (ECF No. 11) recommending that the Commissioner's Motion for an Order Affirming the Decision of the Commissioner (ECF No. 10) be granted, and that Plaintiff's Motion to Reverse with a Remand for Rehearing of the Commissioner's Final Decision (ECF No. 8) be denied.
