After a thorough review of the claims and facts alleged in the Amended Complaint, Magistrate Judge Sullivan found that all four claims failed under the Rule 12(b)(6) standard. (See Report and Recommendation, ECF No. 14.) However, Magistrate Judge Sullivan also recommended that Plaintiff be provided thirty days to correct the deficiencies in the Amended Complaint. (Id.) After an independent review of this matter, the Court agrees with Magistrate Judge Sullivan's analysis and recommendation. The Report and Recommendation (ECF No. 14) is therefore ACCEPTED. Plaintiff is provided thirty days from the date of this Order to file an amended complaint that corrects the deficiencies noted in Magistrate Judge Sullivan's Report and Recommendation.
