The Defendant, Nancy A. Berryhill, Acting Commissioner of Social Security, pursuant to 42 U.S.C. $\S 405(\mathrm{~g})$, has moved to remand this case for further administrative proceedings. (ECF No. 11). The Plaintiff consents to the remand. $I d$. at 2 . The Commissioner states that, on remand, the Appeals Council is to affirm the finding of disability as of May 31, 2017. (ECF No. 11-1 at 1). The Commissioner seeks to have the Appeals Council refer Plaintiff's case to an administrative law judge for further administrative development for the period prior to May 31, 2017. Id.

Pursuant to the power of this court to enter a judgment affirming, modifying, or reversing the Commissioner's decision with remand in Social Security actions under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. $\S 405(\mathrm{~g})$, and in light of the Commissioner's request for remand of this action for further proceedings, this court hereby

ORDERS that the Defendant's motion is granted and this action is REMANDED to the Commissioner for further evaluation pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. $\S 405(\mathrm{~g}) .{ }^{1}$ See Shalala v. Schaefer, 509 U.S. 292 (1993).
