On March 1, 2018, Plaintiff filed a motion seeking \$2,039.06 in attorney's fees and \$22.04 in expenses pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act,¹ asserting the position taken by Defendant in this action was not substantially justified. *See* ECF No. 17. On March 15, 2018, Defendant filed a response to Plaintiff's motion stating she does not oppose payment of the requested amount of attorney's fees and expenses. *See* ECF No. 19.

After careful consideration, the Court **GRANTS** Plaintiff's motion [ECF No. 17] and **ORDERS** Defendant to pay attorney's fees in the amount of \$2,039.06, subject to the Treasury Offset Program² if Plaintiff owes an outstanding debt to the federal government, and expenses in the amount of \$22.04. Pursuant to *Astrue v. Ratliff*, 560 U.S. 586 (2010), the attorney's fees shall be paid directly to Plaintiff and mailed to her attorney, with a copy sent to Plaintiff. **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
