This matter comes before the Court on the Report and Recommendation (R & R) of the Magistrate Judge (Dkt. No. 10), recommending that this action be dismissed for failure to prosecute and failure to comply with an order of the Court.

The Court ADOPTS the R & R (Dkt. No. 10) as an Order of this Court and DISMISSES this action without prejudice.
