This matter comes before the court on Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment as to Defendant Hoover. (ECF No. 73). Defendant Hoover has failed to file a responsive pleading or to enter any appearance at all in this case; as such, the Clerk made an entry of default against Defendant Hoover on August 17, 2010.
