
**ORDER**

The court, having been advised by counsel for the above-captioned parties that the plaintiff has settled with the United States of America, hereby orders that the plaintiff's claims against the United States be dismissed without costs and without prejudice.<sup>1</sup> If settlement between these two parties is not consummated within a reasonable time, either party may, within 60 days, petition the court to reopen the action and restore it to the calendar. *See* Rule 60(b)(6), FED. R. CIV. P. In the alternative, to the extent permitted by law, either party may, within 60 days, petition the court to enforce the settlement. *Fairfax Countywide Citizens v. Fairfax Cnty*, 571 F.2d 1299 (4th Cir. 1978).

The dismissal hereunder shall be *with prejudice* if no action is taken under either alternative within 60 days from the filing date of this order.
