Plaintiff, who is represented by counsel, filed this matter alleging violations of his civil rights by the named defendants. Plaintiff is further advised that if he fails to respond, this action may be decided on the record presented in support of the defendant's motion, <u>see</u> Local Civil Rule 7.06 (D.S.C.), or may be recommended for dismissal with prejudice for failure to prosecute. <u>See Davis</u> v. Williams, 588 F.2d 69, 70 (4th Cir. 1978); Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).
