Defendant, Nancy A. Berryhill, Acting Commissioner of Social Security moves pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for an order of reversal with remand of the cause to the Commissioner for further administrative proceedings. *See Shalala v. Schaefer*, 509 U.S. 292 (1993). Plaintiff does not oppose Defendant's motion. Upon consideration, Defendant's motion (ECF No. 21) is GRANTED. The Court hereby REVERSES the Commissioner's decision in this matter under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g)², and REMANDS the case to the Commissioner for further administrative proceedings.

On remand, the ALJ should specifically: (1) evaluate Plaintiff's claim; (2) offer Plaintiff an opportunity for a hearing; and (3) issue a new decision.
