For good cause shown, this court will amend its pretrial order in this case so as to allow the plaintiff and defendants to each add one additional witness not disclosed at the pretrial conference. The court takes this action after receiving the plaintiff's submission suggesting that he did not receive the court's pretrial order prior to his attendance at the pretrial conference, and the defendants' representation that the existence of their proposed witness was not known prior to the pre-trial conference. These will be the only modifications of the court's pretrial order.

For the reasons set forth above, the pretrial order is hereby amended so as to add Nurse Practitioner Blake, a white female, from Lee Correctional Institution in Bishopville, South Carolina, as a potential plaintiff's witness, who treated the plaintiff for his injuries; and Sergeant Glenn Gatson, an eyewitness, as a potential witness for the defense.

Plaintiff has also requested that the court allow him to add an additional exhibit

specifically, an artificial human head, to illustrate to the jury the plaintiff's injuries. The court will allow this amendment as well, with the clear understanding that the exhibit will be a demonstrative exhibit, not a trial exhibit to go to the jury room during deliberations.
