On January 26, 2016, Plaintiff filed a motion for attorney's fees pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act,<sup>1</sup> asserting the position taken by Defendant in this action was not substantially justified and requesting attorney's fees in the amount of \$3,861.06. *See* ECF No. 21. On February 11, 2016, Defendant filed a response stating she does not object to Plaintiff's requested amount of attorney's fees. *See* ECF No. 22.

After careful consideration, the Court **GRANTS** Plaintiff's motion and **ORDERS** Defendant to pay Plaintiff attorney's fees in the amount of \$3,861.06. Pursuant to *Astrue v. Ratliff*, 560 U.S. 586 (2010), the payment shall be made payable to the claimant and mailed to his attorney, with a copy sent to the claimant. The fees are subject to the Treasury Offset Program<sup>2</sup> if the claimant owes an outstanding debt to the federal government.
