Plaintiff is a prisoner at the Federal Correctional Institution in Edgefield, South Carolina. By Order dated July 19, 2010, Plaintiff was given an opportunity to provide the necessary information and paperwork to bring the case into proper form for evaluation and possible service of process. The case is **dismissed** *without prejudice* pursuant to Rule 41 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. See Link v. Wabash Railroad Company, 370 U.S. 626 (1962).
