In accordance with the accompanying memorandum opinion, the motion for summary judgment filed by Defendants T-Mobile and T-Mobile, USA, Inc. [Court Doc. No. 49] is **DENIED** in part and **GRANTED** in part. Defendant's motion for summary judgment regarding Plaintiff's claims pursuant to the Family Medical Leave Act, 29 U.S.C. §§ 2601 *et seq.* ("FMLA") is **DENIED**. Defendant's motion for summary judgment regarding Plaintiff's claims for discrimination pursuant to the Tennessee Disability Act ("THA"), Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 8-50-103 *et seq.* is **GRANTED**.
