JUDGMENT ORDER

On January 17, 2014, United States Magistrate Judge William B. Mitchell Carter filed a report and recommendation (“R&R”) in this case, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b) (Court File No. 16). Neither party has objected to the R&R within the given fourteen days.

After reviewing the record, the Court agrees with the R&R. The Court hereby **ACCEPTS** and **ADOPTS** the magistrate judge’s findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations.

Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS**:

- (1) Defendant’s motion for summary judgment is **DENIED** (Court File No. 10);
- (2) Plaintiff’s motion for judgment on the pleadings is **GRANTED IN PART** (Court File No. 8); and
- (3) The Commissioner’s decision denying benefits to Plaintiff is **REVERSED** and **REMANDED** pursuant to Sentence Four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for action consistent with the R&R.
