ORDER

This case is before the Court on the Report and Recommendation entered by United States Magistrate Christopher H. Steger, on December 1, 2016 (the "R&R") [Doc. 3]. In the R&R, Magistrate Judge Steger recommends that plaintiff's complaint be dismissed under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2) for failing to state a legal claim upon which relief can be granted, because the claim is barred by the statute of limitations. ORDERS that plaintiff's complaint be **DISMISSED** in its entirety and the Clerk of Court is directed to **CLOSE** this case.
