ORDER

On September 30, 2014, United States Magistrate Judge William B. Mitchell Carter filed a report and recommendation (“R&R”) in this case, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b) (Court File No. 34). Neither party has objected to the R&R within the given fourteen days.
