**ORDER**

This matter is before the court on the April 13, 2016 report and recommendation filed by Magistrate Judge H. Bruce Guyton [doc. 26]. Magistrate Judge Guyton recommends that plaintiff’s motion for attorney fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412, [doc. 22] be granted.
