This civil action is before the court on the Report and Recommendation [doc. 21] filed by United States Magistrate Judge Clifton L. Corker. There have been no timely objections to the Report and Recommendation, and enough time has passed since the filing of the Report and Recommendation to treat any objections as having been waived. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1); Fed.
