ORDER

This civil action is before the Court on the plaintiffs’ Supplemental Motion Pursuant to Rule 32 to Prove Exceptional Circumstances Thus Allowing the Plaintiffs to Use the Videotaped Deposition of Dr. Michael McCollum.
