## <u>ORDER</u>

This civil matter is before the Court on the Report and Recommendation (the "R&R") entered by United States Magistrate Judge H. Bruce Guyton on February 4, 2015 [Doc. 1463]. In the R&R, Magistrate Judge Guyton recommends that the receiver's Thirty-First Application of Receiver for Interim Compensation and Expense Reimbursement [Doc. 1443] be granted. There have been no timely objections to the R&R, and enough time has passed since the filing of the R&R to treat any objections as having been waived. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1); Fed. R. Civ. P. 72.

After a careful review of the matter, the Court is in agreement with Magistrate Judge Guyton's recommendations, which the Court adopts and incorporates into its ruling. Accordingly, the Court **ACCEPTS IN WHOLE** the R&R [Doc. 1463], and hereby **GRANTS** the motion [Doc. 1443]. The receiver is permitted to disburse the

\$7,618.98 requested as compensation for services and reimbursement for expenses for the period from December 1, 2014, and December 31, 2014.
