ORDER

This civil matter is before the Court on the Report and Recommendation (the “R&R”) entered by United States Magistrate Judge C. Clifford Shirley on January 8, 2014 [Doc. 18]. In the R&R, Magistrate Judge Shirley recommended that the Court deny defendant’s Motion to Compel Arbitration and Stay Lawsuit [Doc. 4]. There have been no timely objections to the R&R, and enough time has passed since the filing of the R&R to treat any objections as having been waived. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1); Fed. R. Civ.
