## <u>ORDER</u>

Pending before the Court is Plaintiff Jonathan B. Wright's Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings ("Motion") (Doc. No. 12). Defendant Commissioner of Social Security filed a Response opposing Plaintiff's Motion (Doc. No. 16). Subsequently, Magistrate Judge Bryant issued a Report and Recommendation ("Report") recommending that the Motion be denied. (Doc. No. 19 at 12.)
