Petitioner has neglected, however, to either pay the fee required for the filing of the petition or submit a properly completed application to proceed *in forma pauperis*.


Accordingly, the Petitioner is hereby **GRANTED** thirty (30) days from the date of entry of this order on the docket in which to either pay the filing fee of five dollars (\$5.00) or submit an application to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

The Clerk will provide the Petitioner with a blank application to proceed *in forma pauperis* along with a copy of Administrative Order No. 93.

The Petitioner is forewarned that, should he fail to comply with these instructions within the specified period of time, the Court will presume that he is not interested in pursuing this matter and will dismiss the case for want of prosecution. Rule 41(b), Fed. R. Civ. P.
