ORDER

Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion for Judgment on the Administrative Record ("Motion") (Doc. No. 14), filed with a Brief in Support (Doc. No. 15). Defendant Commissioner of Social Security filed a Response opposing Plaintiff's Motion. (Doc. No. 16.)
