
ORDER and FINAL JUDGMENT

Before the Court is Plaintiff Thomas D. Woodard's Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings (Doc. No. 21) and supporting memorandum (Doc. No. 21) seeking judicial review of the Commissioner's denial of his claim for Social Security Disability Insurance Benefits ("DIB") and Supplemental Security Income ("SSI"). The Court hereby withdraws the reference of this case heretofore made to the Magistrate Judge.

For the reasons set forth in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, the Court finds that the ALJ's decision is supported by substantial evidence in the record, and that the ALJ applied the correct legal principles in reaching his decision. Accordingly, the Plaintiff's Motion (Doc. No. 21) is **DENIED** and the decision of the Commissioner **AFFIRMED**. Judgment is hereby entered in favor of the Commissioner and this matter is **DISMISSED**.

It is so **ORDERED**.
