



ORDER

For the reasons explained in the accompanying Memorandum, the Court DENIES Tyson’s motion to reconsider the Court’s January 30, 2014 bifurcation order, (Docket No. 284); DENIES Tyson’s motion for judgment on the pleadings (which the Court treats as a motion for partial summary judgment), (Docket No. 286); and GRANTS Plaintiffs’ cross-motion for partial summary judgment as to Tyson’s liability for work Plaintiffs perform during the “bookends” of the 30-minute unpaid periods.
