
ORDER

Pending before the Court is Plaintiff Derek E. Allen’s Motion for Judgment on the Administrative Record (“Motion”) (Doc. No. 14), filed with a Brief in Support (Doc. No. 14-1). Defendant Commissioner of Social Security filed a Response opposing the Motion. (Doc. No. 15), to which Plaintiff filed a Reply (Doc. No. 16). Defendant then filed a substituted administrative record (Doc. No. 20), prompting Plaintiff to file a Supplemental Reply Brief (Doc. No. 19), to which Defendant filed a Reply (Doc. No. 23), and Plaintiff filed a Sur-reply (Doc. No. 24). Subsequently, Magistrate Judge Griffin issued a Report and Recommendation (“Report”), recommending that the Motion be denied. (Doc. No. 27 at 47.) The Report was filed on March 20, 2014, and provided a period of fourteen days in which either party could file an objection. (*Id.*) Neither party has filed an objection to date.

Upon review of this matter, the Court finds the Report to be well-founded and **ADOPTS** it in its entirety. Accordingly, the Court hereby **DENIES** Plaintiff’s Motion (Doc. No. 14) and **AFFIRMS** the decision of the Commissioner. The Clerk of the Court is **DIRECTED** to close the case.

It is so ORDERED.
