**ORDER** 

Pending before the Court is a Report and Recommendation ("R & R") of the Magistrate

Judge, recommending that Defendant's Motion to Dismiss for Failure to Prosecute (Docket

Entry No. 21) be granted. The R & R provides, in part,

Accordingly, the Court hereby rules as follows:

(1) The Report and Recommendation (Docket Entry No. 24) is hereby ACCEPTED and APPROVED; and

(2) Defendant's Motion to Dismiss for Failure to Prosecute (Docket Entry No. 21) is hereby GRANTED; and

(3) Plaintiff Linda S. Brown's Complaint is hereby DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

The Clerk is directed to enter Judgment in a separate document in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 58.
